INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES.

DATE: 21.03.2021, Time: 11.00 AM to 12 NOON, VENUE: ACADEMY BUILDING

- The examination will be of 1 hour duration from 11.00 AM to 12 Noon.
- Candidates should report at the venue 1 hour before the scheduled time of examination.
- **Mobile phones, pagers or any other electronic device will not be allowed in the examination hall.**
- All the candidates should be seated in their allotted seats 10 minutes before the scheduled time of examination.
- **No candidate will be allowed to enter the examination hall 10 minutes after the commencement of the examination.**
- No one would be allowed to leave the hall before 30 minutes from the time of commencement of the examination.
- **Candidates will be allowed to carry only the admit card and pen in the examination hall. No one will be allowed to enter the examination hall without the original admit card received by post.**
- The test will be of single response MCQ type examination.
- There will be 35 questions of 1 mark each.
- **The answers should be marked with blue ball point pen only.**
- Only single correct response should be marked. **Questions marked with multiple responses or any overwriting, will be considered as incorrect.**
- There will be **no negative marking** for incorrect answer.
